How Do You Measure the Worth of a Man?

It was brought to my attention some time ago that the physical body has very little value in monetary terms. Its worth was said to be less than a dollar. So you can see how easy it is for a person to cling to the thought that his life may amount to only a little or absolutely nothing at all.

From God's point of view, He sees you as invaluable. I invite you to agree with these lyrics, "How do you measure the worth of a man?" The songwriter's answer is to "look at his life through heaven's eyes."

Be resolved that you were fearfully and wonderfully made by God. What makes everyone so valuable is God designed mankind after the image and likeness of Himself, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Genesis 2:7 confirms you are more than a mud pie. It says, "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul."

Once you understand your own worth and value through the lens of Scripture, you will become more confident that God already marked your wealthy place as well. The term "wealthy" in biblical terms means to be moist, i.e., no more drought. God wants you to experience an unending flow of harvest that steadily increases you more and more with no visible signs of lack, debt, or poverty.

Provision for Adam can be clearly seen when God prepared an abundant land expressly for him before he was even created. Genesis 2:11-12 shows that one of the provisions God created was good gold. "The name of the first [river] is Pishon; that is it which compasseth the whole land of Hav'ilah, where there is gold; and the gold of that land is good:..." What God calls "good" is what you and I refer to as excellent. The Lord's divine purpose is to improve your quality of life in the earth with heaven as His model.

God charged Adam in Genesis 1:28 to "be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it." *The New Scofield Reference Bible* interprets the word subdue as to "acquire a knowledge and mastery over his material environment to bring its elements into the service of the race." In other words, God gave dominion to man to rule over money and everything else and not to allow money and everything else to rule over him. This charge is still effective today. God would not have had to give Adam this charge if there was nothing for him to rule over.

Know this: It is God's will and His original intent for you to prosper in every area of your life. III John 2 is one of God's precious promises to you that confirm His original purpose. It declares, "Beloved, I wish [will in the Greek language] above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospereth."

The word prospereth found in the *Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible* from the Greek dictionary means "to do well, well done". It is derived from a root word that means "to progress the route, act, or distance," (e.g., to help on the road, to succeed in reaching, and to succeed in business affairs). When you make room for the Lord to fully channel Himself through your soul -- mind, will, and emotions -- you will come forth like pure gold, with no raw materials or scraps left.

Your soul must be restored before the Holy Spirit can lead you into the paths of righteousness for His name sake. From restoration, you will experience satisfaction, evidenced by you being filled with the fullness of God. Let your testimony be as Psalm 17:15 declares, "As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness."

Pathway to Prosperity addresses four different levels that yield your increase. Revealed in the Book of Ruth in the Holy Bible, they are: 1) The gleaner; 2) the reaper; 3) the partaker; and 4) the owner. Gleaning is a type of honorable work designed to supply the poor. Reaping is the laborer who is worthy of his hire so he receives a paycheck. Partaking is the one who receives increase by invitation to be someone's guest. Owning is the one who receives an inheritance by favor because his name is written in the last will and testament. I invite you to read the four short

chapters that make up the Book of Ruth to familiarize yourself with the story.

No matter what path you are on, God's design is for you to receive your full rights as an heir of God and a joint heir with Jesus Christ. God desires to raise you up as His own son through legal adoption. His desire is for you to fully mature so your territory will be enlarged in the earth for His glory and for your good.

He designed you to have the supply so you will be in demand. How else can you be a lender unto nations, and not a borrower? How else can you have advantageous returns on all your investments? The Lord doesn't just want you to just manage your money but to skillfully master your God-given inheritance.

Chapter One

I'll Clear the Path for You

In the kingdom of God, your pathway to total life prosperity has already been prearranged. Designed by God the path out before you may include a number of different places, but most assuredly they all will be exclusively for you. In fact, after connecting the divine dots, your destiny will image God's own dynasty in the earth -- the kingdom of God.

As Deuteronomy 11 declares, the Promised Land is a land that flows with milk and honey that God always takes care of from the beginning of each year unto the end of each year. "...Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain; and the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it," Isaiah 40:3-5.

Each appointed place has been proclaimed as a registered landmark within the kingdom of God. All noted landmarks represent important events in the development of your pathway to prosperity. One thing you must be confident of is that He will never leave or forsake you. Isaiah 48:17 illustrates God's role as your Teacher and Leader of Profit. "Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the Lord thy God who teacheth thee to profit, who leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go."

In following the Good Shepherd, you may often be acquainted with: green pastures, still waters, restored soul, paths of righteousness, the valley of the shadow of death, the presence of the Lord, comfort from His rod of correction and His staff of direction, a prepared table in the presence of your enemies, the anointing, the cup running over, and the house of the Lord forever.

On the other hand, there may be hidden land mines the enemy sets up as traps in an attempt to try to get you off the path. satan schemes to cause you to crouch so that you will cringe. His plot is to keep you contained, get you to retreat,

and ultimately destroy you. Luke 4:13 refers to the enemy's plot as a cycle of temptation: "And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him [Jesus] for a season." satan always only leaves when he is defeated.

An example of the devil's craftiness can be found when the children of Israel turned an 11 day trip to the promise land into a 40 year journey. One Bible reference shows their footprints continuously going around in the same circle until they finally crossed over to the promise land.

Similar to the demanding and thirsty wilderness, the world's system has been framed to kill, steal, and destroy you and your possessions knowingly or unknowingly. Knowing mankind's insatiable appetite, the world system images a mirage that appears to be the crème of the crop, when in actuality it is the bottom of the barrel.

Being subject to the world's system, you will find that it doesn't end, except in destruction. All your possessions will be captured and proudly stored in the enemy's camp. Because there is movement, the world system perpetrates advancement. In reality, you are only going around in circles.

Some of the systems that have been designed to keep you contained or to bring you into default are: fixed income, welfare, crime, lottery, gambling, credit cards, loans, debt, and bankruptcy. The list goes on and on.

For instance, the world system develops solutions to only pacify problems. In reality, new problems are created. In an attempt to alleviate the new problem, the solution is discontinued, which in many cases pulls the rug out from under an unsuspecting beneficiary. This is how you can tell if God is in the designer or not. God's pathway always makes the resolution that brings an end to the problem permanently.

There are also systems that have been inherited from one generation to the next generation. These systems attempt to lure you into accepting the apparent fate of your own heritage: lack of opportunities, lack of education, prison life, alcoholism, drug addiction, sickness, incurable diseases, ultimately, premature death. All these keep you in a neverending flow - the cycle of death - but not if you abide in the pathway designed by God.

There is always a way of escape in the Master's Plan, God's pathway to divine prosperity. You can break the cycle that has confined you even if it has plagued your family for generations. One of my mentors always says that it is insane to think you can keep doing the same thing but get different results. God has a new and living way awaiting you that leads you to the land that flows with milk and honey.

Learn to walk in the Spirit. In the Greek language, the word walk means to "keep up with" the Holy Spirit. Since the world system attempts to hide its hand through the deceitfulness of riches, you must engage the Holy Spirit to lead you into all truth where prosperity is concerned.

In other words, the world system wants you to believe that its way will usher you into a quick and easy return on your investment. This is far from the truth, because God has pronounced its judgment, even now, as a condemned system. So you see, it is designed for you to put your trust in something that has already been pronounced as a failure.

You can learn to move with precision by trusting the Word of God and the Spirit of God. Statistics show that 80 percent of all success is achieved through clarity. When you use God's compass to identify His purpose and plan for your life, the remaining 20 percent will be focused on walking it out. Psalm 25:12-13 from *The Living Bible* shows when you position God first and foremost in all your ways that He will direct your path. "Where is the man who fears the Lord? God will teach him how to choose the best. He shall live within God's circle of blessing, and his children shall inherit the earth."

Let your scriptural confession be, The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. My ears are awakened morning by morning to hear as the learned, so I will not revolt against the truth. I know my Good Shepherd's voice and another I will not follow. In Him, I live, I move, and I have my being. I will not miss any of God's ordered steps in His Word. I am synchronized with the Spirit of God and empowered by the Wisdom of God. I am walking in the good, acceptable, and perfect Will of God. I am blessed and highly favored of the Lord. In Jesus name. Amen.
