I. God's Exhibition in the Earth

A. God established the earth by his faith using the works he finished before the foundation of the world.

1. He had a well thought out, detailed master plan. (Hebrews 4:3)
2. **Day One:** Created light and separated it from darkness (Genesis 1:2-5)
3. **Day Two:** Divided the waters from the sky (Genesis 1:6-8)
4. **Day Three:** Separated the waters from the Earth and caused the Earth to produce. (Genesis 1:9-13)
5. **Day Four:** Established sun, moon, stars (Genesis 1:14-19)
6. **Day Five:** Populated the waters with fish and the sky with birds, etc. (Genesis 1:20-23)
7. **Day Six:** Populated the Earth with animals and made Adam & Eve (Genesis 1:24-31)
8. **Day Seven:** Rested because his work was finished. (Genesis 2:1-2)
9. Reference: Genesis chapters 1 and 2; Hebrews 4th chapter

B. God brought about divine order, balance, wholeness, fullness, overflow and excess by his love, power, and a sound mind.

1. "O Lord, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches. So is this great and wide sea, wherein are things creeping innumerable, both small and great beasts. There go the ships: there is that leviathan, whom thou hast made to play therein. These wait all upon thee; that thou mayest give them their meat in due season. That thou givest them they gather: thou openest thine hand, they are filled with good." (Psalm 104:24-28)
2. References: Psalm 104; Proverbs 8; Job 28:23-28

C. God created man in his own image and his own likeness to operate exactly like he does, i.e., to receive the same immediate results that he did when he created the world.

1. "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth [even the creep, satan and his demons]." Genesis 1:26)
2. Reference: Genesis 1:26-28

D. God gave that same pattern to mankind to create his own world by faith.

1. "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." (Hebrews 11:3)

2. References: Colossians 1:9-11, Hebrews 11th chapter

E. Selah! Exercise

1. Reflect on your total financial life and determine if you genuinely have faith in God in that area. If you feel insecure, i.e., not resting nor quiet, you are not in faith, but operating out of fear.

2. If you have truly transferred your trust to God in an area, you will have Scripture(s) that support your claim to have your financial promises fulfilled.

3. Your mouth serves as the qualified informant that discerns the level of faith you are truthfully operating at to receive your increase from God. The following are death sentences: I can't afford it. I'm broke as a joke. Another day, another dollar. I'm in the poor house. I'm robbing Peter to pay Paul. It can only be truth to you when you accept it as truth.

4. Chart the financial areas you praise God about on one side and chart the financial areas you complain about on the other side.

5. Identify and daily exercise aloud financial Scriptures that will help you erase your complaints and bring them to the praise side.

i. Complaints to God and complaints about God are quite different.

a. Complaints about God simply mean you believe he is not taking good care of you, so he is your problem.

b. Complaints to God mean you believe he has the resolution. In this case, you choose to lean on the Lord because he is your solution, not your problem.

6. Whatever God originally created can undergo an extreme makeover if necessary. Because he has the patent on the original design, he is empowered to recreate it to bring about full restoration in every area of your life.

II. God's Distribution of the Earth

A. God divided the earth into portions so that its land could be shared by all its inhabitants.

1. "The heavens, even the heavens, are the Lord's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men." (Psalm 115:16)

B. God allotted a generous portion of the earth to everyone to greatly enlarge their own territory.

1. No one needs to fight over land or swindle anyone out of their property.
2. There is enough Promised Land for everyone to freely spread out without restriction of space.

C. What you receive in this life is up to you. No man and no devil can stop you from making any transaction unless you issue them a permit to stop work.

1. It doesn't matter how you got your start in life.
2. It matters most that you finish well.

D. How you personally invest intimate time in the presence of the Lord determines the quality and the quantity of your success.

1. Every convenience was made i.e., airplane, microwave, computers, telephones, etc., to redeem your personal and work time, so you could carve out uninterrupted, quality time daily to fellowship with the Lord.
2. The way you seek the Lord has never changed since the beginning of time. But when you seek the Lord, you will change to become more of an asset to the kingdom of God and not a liability.
3. God will teach you how to profit and lead you by the way you should go to keep you aligned with the Word of God.
4. God will prompt you how, when, and where to use every available resource and opportunity made or presented to you to build your economic portfolio when you fellowship with him in the secret place.
5. "Come, and let us return unto the Lord: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. After two days will he revive us, in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as he rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth." (Hosea 6:1-3)

E. What you carve out by faith as your possessions will determine your influence with God, man, and satan.

1. Don't allow your world to fit into someone else's mold.

2. Carve out the territory God already traced for you and never settle for less.
3. Be pliable so God can stretch and shape your faith to get immediate results.

F. Selah! Exercise

1. Calculate what you own and owe. When you add everything up, are you operating in the red, in debt, lack, and poverty, or operating in the black, assets are greater than your liabilities?
2. Determine what you rent and/or lease vs. own. If you have made a decision to be an owner then discover the path that will lead you to it.
3. Design what you want it to look like on paper first so you can identify it once you see it.
4. Identify for what purpose you are spending your time, money, energy and relationships.
 - i. For your time, chart how you invest your time during the week and on weekends. Read time management books to help you get control of wasted time. Throughout your day always ask yourself, what is the most valuable use of your time right now?
 - ii. For your money, get out your checkbook or cash receipts for at least one month and tally them. Read money management books to help you get control of your wasted money. What is the most valuable use of your money right now?
 - iii. Regarding relationships, take a good look at your family, friends, and foes that you interact with all the time. Identify what kind of leverage they have in your life to keep you in the same place, build you up, or tear you down. Allow the Holy Spirit to help you discern their place in your current and future expansion plans. Who is most valuable to you right now?
 - iv. Identify what changes you can make and keep consistently flowing, even if they are small ones that will enrich your life. This is not equivalent to a new year's resolution. Don't wait until tomorrow. Faith has the capacity to do it now! Creating leverage with at least one person you highly respect has the power to keep you going and growing until you reach your goal.

III. God's Visitation to the Earth

A. God continues to supply the earth when he is extended an invitation.

1. God already prepared more than enough
 - i. to supply every need
 - ii. to fulfill every desire of the heart
 - iii. to release the exceeding, abundant, above all that man could ask for or think about
2. God has a ready supply for any demand because his grace is sufficient.
3. "Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it; thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: thou preparest corn, when thou hast so provided for it. Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof. Thou crownest the year with goodness; and thy paths drop fatness [excess]." (Psalm 65:9-11)
4. Reference Psalm 65

B. To receive his abundant supply, make room for the Lord to freely work in your life unhindered.

1. He never barges in unannounced but arrives when ample space is made available for him to work.
2. Prepare the way for him by extending an open, seeking, hearing, and receiving heart.
3. Praise and worship the Lord for who he is and not just for what he has done and will do for you.

C. God works through man employing the Law of Harvest to replenish the earth.

1. When God becomes your Lord of the Harvest, you can expect a continual flow of uninterrupted substance. (Isaiah 55:10-11)
2. The Law of Harvest remains in effect throughout all ages. (Genesis 8:22)
 - i. Agriculture
 - ii. Hunting
 - iii. Industrial
 - iv. Information
 - v. Wisdom

D. The Birthright-Blessing is your inheritance when we become an adopted son or daughter of God.

1. God has carved out an inheritance for everyone so each can receive the influence of the firstborn, Jesus Christ

- i. The birthright bestows the leading sequence for the chosen; you become the head, not the tail.
 - ii. The blessing bestows the leading substance for the chosen; you are full, not empty.
2. How much value is placed on the inheritance God distributed?
- i. Seduced
 - a. Adam's allowed his inheritance to be seduced (Genesis 3rd chapter)
 - b. The Fall of Man lost the inheritance (Genesis 3:15-19)
 - 1) demoted to a reaper
 - 2) evicted from his home, the Garden of Eden
 - 3) death was generated
 - 4) warfare with satan was introduced
 - 5) sorrow and pain in childbearing
 - 6) male dominance over the woman in the home
 - 7) failure in the workplace
 - 8) lifelong grief
 - 9) hard labor
 - 10) ruled by the world system
 - ii. Surrendered
 - a. Esau surrendered his inheritance to pacify his hunger. (Genesis 25:27-34; Genesis 27:30-46)
 - iii. Seized
 - a. Jacob was tricked out of his inheritance (Genesis 27:1-29; Genesis 29th-31st chapters)
 - iv. Spent
 - a. The younger prodigal wasted all his inheritance on riotous living (Luke 15:1-24)
 - v. Saved
 - a. The older prodigal saved all his inheritance and never enjoyed any of it. (Luke 15:25-32)
 - vi. Satisfied
 - a. Jesus Christ is satisfied with his inheritance because his greatest sacrifice brought many souls into the kingdom of God, restoring God's family to him. (Isaiah 53rd chapter)
 - 1) Jesus Christ gave us a second chance of returning to the lifestyle that was in the Garden of Eden.
 - 2) Jesus did not receive his inheritance for selfish reasons, but everything he did always included God and us.
3. An incorruptible inheritance

- i. No matter how much or how little you possess, the secret to your success is that your work can be tried by fire and still be left standing.
 - a. The key to your work outlasting heat is that it must be established in the kingdom of God's mission, which is winning souls for Jesus Christ.
 - b. Anything left after a fire is eternal.
- ii. Reference Matthew 25:14-30; John 6:27

E. Selah! Exercise

1. Do you just wait for God's deposits in an emergency or are you God's dwelling place in the earth?
2. Reflect on your personal relationship with God. How well do you know him? Or do you just know about him? Are you only depending on others to reach God for you?
3. Determine to establish a two-way conversation with the Lord daily. Carve out time that only belongs to him. Allow time everyday and throughout the day to commune with him: speaking to him in Scriptures and songs and then removing distractions so you can quiet yourself before him to accurately listen to his small, soft voice on the inside.
4. When you pray determine if you are seeking his face or his hand? Provision requires priority.
5. Can you envision God saying to you, "well done my good and faithful servant" and then giving you a promotion? If you can't, begin to work on an indelible picture of attaining the highest level.
6. If you are anything other than satisfied, if you deem it appropriate, ask God to forgive you for not pursuing the mastery he has already given you. Ask him to lead and guide you into all truth, so you will operate after the counsel of his will for your inheritance and give him ample room for habitation in your life.

IV. The Two Financial Systems on Earth

A. The World System is a Counterfeit Plan

1. "There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." (Proverbs 16:25)
2. The world system paints an indelible picture as the only way to do business, implying that you can't add to it nor take away from it.
3. Its principles and practices are considered absolute truths that are impossible to stop, change, reverse, or overthrow.
4. It looks like a maze so it puzzles many people to the extent that they cannot envision overthrowing it but only accepting its lot in life.
5. It makes no inhabitable space for God to work in.

B. The World System is a "WYSIWYG"

1. WYSIWYG is the acrostic for, "What you see is what you get".
2. What you see is a crafty tool to get you to accept all seen facts, false reports, and opinion polls, even rumors as the undeniable, unchangeable truth.
3. Because of its accepted practices, many people believe they are subject to every decision made by it with no possible way of escape.

C. The World System uses, misuses, and/or abuses commonly Known Practices to Create Patterns of Destruction

1. Taking chances on legalized or illegal lottery, gambling, numbers
2. Economy or economic indicators
3. Credit card frenzy
4. Get rich quick schemes
5. Stock market (normally fluctuate according to rumors)
6. Borrower servant to the lender, default and foreclosures
7. Inflation
8. Depression or recession
9. Fixed income: retirement; social security; government welfare system
10. Injustice: corporate slavery; glass ceiling; discrimination; fear of retaliation
11. Caste system
12. Filing bankruptcy or other lawsuits
13. Government subsidies: (pay farmers not to grow)

14. Negative spirit of inheritance
 - i. proudly accepts predecessors' way of life as an absolute no matter how desolate
 - ii. Ignorant about ancestor's lifestyle back to the third and fourth generations
15. Corporate corruption, extortion, and lobbying to take bribes
16. Downsizing, layoffs, mergers
17. Illegal gains and fraud
18. Horoscopes, voodoo, witchcraft, occult, readers, psychics, etc., and even fiction books promoting such practices. (This is not entertainment, but demonic influence)
19. Identity theft and other crimes that take advantage
20. public acknowledgment of satan worship that grants its subject temporary relief in this world
21. Employers delay or defraud workers of pay checks, raises, previously earned vacation and/or sick time, and retirements
22. Accepting clichés as the absolute truth e.g., the rich get richer and the poor gets poorer.
23. Predatory lending, discriminatory loan markups, reverse mortgages
24. Contractors' nonpayment or slow payment on executed contracts in an effort to close businesses that already have performed the work.
25. Unfortunately, there are churches and ministries who are committed to doing some of the above mentioned practices by posturing themselves like the world system by promoting idols for people to worship. This answers the question why Jesus turned over the money tables in the temple. (Mark 11:15-17)

D. The World System Environment and Culture

1. satan is the god of the world system. (Ephesians 6:10-18)
 - i. the chain of command is
 - a. principalities
 - b. powers
 - c. spiritual wickedness in high places
 - d. rulers of darkness of this world
 - ii. satan's reign is short lived.
 - a. "And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever." (Revelation 20:10)

- iii. the kingdom of this world will be dissolved by the reign of God in the earth.
 - a. "The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ; and he shall reign forever and ever". (Revelation 11:15)
- 2. satan strategically uses four weapons to abort your harvest once the seed of the Word has been sown. (Mark 4:1-20)
 - i. The four weapons against the Word of God are
 - a. steals, so you will be hollow on the inside
 - b. persecutes, so you will make haste
 - c. distracts, so you will get hitched to something else for it to be your source
 - d. offends, so you will feel hurt
 - ii. Having firsthand knowledge of how the kingdom of God works, satan purposes to demonstrate that the Word of God does not work.
 - iii. The Word of God is the supreme weapon of our warfare that causes satan to flee in terror, because he has dread of you using the Word on him to reign triumphantly
- 3. The natural and spiritual cycle of death includes, but is not limited to the following:

4. Operates under the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:2)

- i. Because it is a law, it works the same way every time no matter who practices it.

- ii. The offspring of lust is sin.
 - iii. When sin is finished, it reaps death. (James 1:13-15)
5. Uses imagination to exalt itself against the knowledge of God. (II Corinthians 10:1-6)
- i. satan paints an indelible word picture or vision to convince you not to believe something he knows without a shadow of doubt is the absolute truth.
6. Harvests the curse of the law. (Deuteronomy 28:15-68)
7. Labors to be rich only to fulfill own selfish lusts. (Proverbs 23:4)
8. Promotes the spirit of the Antichrist. (I John 4:1-4)
- i. It denies Jesus Christ full access so habitation is impossible.
 - ii. It holds captives in bondage.
 - iii. It protests against liberty.
 - iv. It is the complete opposite of the anointing of Christ because it adds with an attempt to multiply your sorrow by burdens and yokes. (Matthew 12:30)
9. Plays mind games
- i. Blinds the mind from the light (II Corinthians 4:4)
 - ii. Torments the carnal mind which leads to death (Romans 8:6)
10. It is preoccupied with consuming temporal selfish needs and comforts only. (Matthew 6:31-32)
- a. eating
 - b. drinking
 - c. clothes
 - d. worries about tomorrow
 - e. keeps you toiling instead of resting
11. Despises the Word of God.
- i. It makes the Word ineffective when tradition is accepted as a way of life. (Mark 7:13)
 - ii. It makes you stagger at the Word through unbelief. (Romans 4:20-21)
12. satan poses as an angel of light. (II Corinthians 11:14)
- i. creates laws that are an abomination to God. (Psalm 94:20).
 - ii. people judge evil as good when laws legalize a particular area although the bible declares it as an abomination to God.
13. Introduces the world as a friend (James 4:4)
- i. covers up the inevitable destruction to show the pleasure side only
 - ii. deceives you into believing his lies are the absolute truth

14. Overrules the mind of Christ through the power of suggestion: (Psalm 1)
 - i. The counsel of the ungodly
 - a. denies the honor, glory, and majesty of your authority in the kingdom of God really exists.
 - ii. The way of the sinner
 - a. rejects Jesus as Savior and Lord because they see no value in serving him.
 - iii. The seat of the scornful
 - a. to reposition you by mocking your life in Christ as make believe or irrelevant to the times.
15. Always uses the same pattern of temptation (Matthew 4:1-11)
 - i. Lead me not into temptation
 - a. satisfy the lust of the flesh
 - b. satisfy the lust of the eyes
 - c. satisfy the pride of life
 - ii. Jesus' temptation and triumph
 - a. desired Jesus to abuse his power by turning the stone into bread to satisfy his hunger pangs.
 - b. desired to reposition Jesus under him by offering him the kingdoms of this world without a fight so satan could easily gain rule of the world.
 - c. desired Jesus to commit suicide to cause premature death and a failed mission, to overthrow succession.
 - iii. Deliver me from evil
 - a. tempts you to lose, refuse, abuse or misuse your authority in Christ just to have instant gratification
 - b. tempts you to worship satan in exchange for something you most desire in this world
 - c. tempts you to end it all so you can't finish your assignment on earth.
16. Targets Proper Succession (Genesis 3rd chapter)
 - i. The practices of the world system infect poison into the blood stream of the current generation.
 - a. If left unchecked, it can quickly exterminate the incumbents as well as those generations that follow.
 - ii. If Jesus followed the dictates of satan, he would have cut us off from our inheritance and foiled the plan of God.
 - a. There would be no succession plan within the kingdom of God
 - b. Your promise of bountiful provision would have been cut off.
 - c. Your promise of reaching your potential would have been cut off.
 - d. Your promise of great posterity would have been cut off.

E. How does the world system oppose the kingdom of God?

1. Caters to satisfying the five physical senses.

- i. see
- ii. hear
- iii. smell
- iv. touch
- v. taste

a. "Love not the world, neither the things are in the world. If any man loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of flesh, and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of the Father abideth forever." (I John 2:15-17)

2. Advocates only having their portion in this life.

i. They do everything for the here and now without any regard for eternity. (Psalm 17:8-15)

3. Expects instant gratification (Proverbs 28:20)

- i. always acts out of desperation
- ii. comforts the skinless flesh
- iii. rebels against maturity through its display of childish, selfish behavior
- iv. willing to pay the cost for convenience which is usually much higher
- v. tends to live for the day so will splurge without preparing for the future
- vi. highly regards the fear of death because they believe tomorrow is not promised, so preparation is never made for the future
- vii. looks for the easy way out
- viii. urges you to operate out of sequence just to get ahead, although the foundation has been proven weak

4. Promotes resolution, but can only give momentary relief for a huge price, your soul (John 14:27)

5. Boasts about gain without godliness (I Timothy 6:5)

- i. pursues greed
- ii. shows no restraints
- iii. supports addictive behaviors
- iv. bent on increase even at the expense of committing crimes or wrongdoing. (I Samuel 8:3)
- v. arrogant about own abilities and accomplishments
- vi. promotes increase without the authority of Christ
- vii. takes advantage of people

- a. they will do anything just to be in your presence because of your influential status
- 6. Avows independence (Isaiah 14:12-17)
 - i. If all you have in life are your own resources although they may seem great, you are still taking a chance on coming home empty without any means of restoration.
 - ii. gives worship to satan, which makes you an enemy of God
 - iii. makes you an offspring of treason, whereby you will overthrow the kingdom of God by choice like Adam and Eve dethroned God
 - iv. enthrones self as god which creates irreconcilable differences between you and God, unless you repent and learn to live forgiven
 - v. alienated from the life of God so you can't experience Jesus living the rest of his life in the earth through you. (Ephesians 4:17-19)
 - vi. asserts right to choose own way which makes you an open target for desolation.
 - a. "And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins: Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: That at that time were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself twain one new man, so making peace; And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby; and came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh. For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father." (Ephesians 2:1-2, 12-18)
- 7. Gives no relevance to living by faith
 - i. It does not honor God nor the operation of the faith principle (Romans 14:23)
 - ii. Because it is independent of God's influence it uses anything other than faith to get ahead.
 - a. "Divers weights, and divers measures, both of them are alike abomination to the Lord." (Proverbs 20:10)
 - iii. It is resolved that faith is foolish and presumptuous.
- 8. Promotes idolatry as the only god to serve
 - i. Money is the world system's idol which means you will knowingly or unknowingly serve it.

- a. “The idols of the heathen are silver and gold, the work of men’s hands. They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes have they, but they see not; They have ears, but they hear not; neither is there any breath in their mouths. They that make them are like unto them; so is every one that trusteth in them.” (Psalm 135:15-18)
 - ii. Establishes a wrong relationship with money, because you have not learned to master it.
 - iii. Under the guise of idolatry, money becomes your god, which means you may be willing to engage in any activity just to have it.
- 9. Seeks to change the times and laws of God. (Daniel 7:25)
 - i. If the times are changed, then your faith can't operate as though the works of God were finished from the foundation of the world and ready to be delivered to you. Delays are created because of unbelief.
 - ii. If the laws are changed, then you will accuse God of not keeping his promises. You even may begin to think that faith is futile and a waste of time. Mistrust is created because of unbelief.
 - iii. If the enemy can wear out the saints by sending messages that God is tardy, then procrastination and delays will be accepted as your way of life.
 - iv. Because procrastination was sown as a seed, a like harvest of procrastination will be your return on investment.
 - a. You can't experience on-time delivery without synchronization.
- 10. Desires every decision made not to be filtered through the Word of God so that the kingdom of God won't advance.
 - i. There are two types of wisdom operating in the earth.
 - a. Every choice you make that supports the kingdom of this world allows you to enjoy pleasures for a season.
 - b. Every choice you make that supports the kingdom of God replants you in the Garden of Eden.
 - ii. "Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him hew out of a good conversation [lifestyle] his works with meekness of wisdom. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace." (James 3:13-18)
- 11. Entangles with a yoke of bondage to trap the offspring born of the free (Galatians 4:19-5:1)
 - i. covenant of bondage in the kingdom of this world
 - a. born of the flesh

- b. offspring of a bond maid
- c. persecutes those born after the Spirit
- d. shall not be an heir with the offspring of the free
- ii. covenant of liberty in the kingdom of God
 - a. born of the Spirit
 - b. by a freewoman
 - c. cast out the bondmaid and her offspring
 - d. shall not dwell side by side with those born of the flesh

F. The Kingdom of God System is the Original Plan of God

1. Discern the authenticity of a plan
 - i. Industries like banking teach people how to detect what is genuine by using real currency, not counterfeit money.
 - ii. The Holy Spirit is the official teacher of the church who uses the Word of God as his text book from which to prove your faith.
 - iii. God has **not** employed satan as a substitute teacher to prepare you for your proficiency test. (Psalm 105:19)
 - iv. satan never creates, he only perverts.
2. Understand the distinction between heaven and the kingdom of God
 - i. The first heaven is the sky area right above us.
 - ii. The second heaven is known as the outer space.
 - iii. The third heaven is where God and Jesus live. Heaven is a literal place. Jesus is now preparing a place for us there. (Ecclesiastes 5:2)
 - iv. The kingdom of God is in the earth. It is the space God desires to occupy first in your heart and then in your environment. Wherever he is invited as Lord that is the same place he can reign through you. Whenever you continue to enthrone him in everything, then he can enlarge his territory in the earth until every inch is under his rule. (Luke 17:20-21)

G. The highest quality of life in the earth for the believer is readily accessible now. Breakthrough is yours now!

1. "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)
2. "That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the Lord sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth" (Deuteronomy 11:21)
3. Put the above two Scriptures in your daily prayer journal because they represent habitation to the greatest degree possible.

H. What happens when the kingdom of God challenges the kingdoms of this world?

1. "The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ; and he shall reign forever and ever". (Revelation 11:15)

i. The world shall be generated into the kingdom of God as an offspring that the believer helps to mature as sons of God.

ii. Even if those in the world don't choose salvation, they won't be in charge when you rule through your authority in prayer.

iii. Even if those in the world remain in charge for a time, they still will be subject to the dominion of the body of Christ through your authority in prayer.

2. The believer's request to God is to receive the inheritance that he has marked out for us.

i. "Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen [nations] for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession." (Psalm 2:7)

3. God's vengeance against the world system will turn the world upside down so we can receive our rightful inheritance.

i. Reference: Psalm 94th chapter

I. The conferred authority of Matthew

i. Recorded more accounts about the kingdom of God than any other gospel writers, i.e., Mark, Luke, and John

ii. Understood the revelation about the kingdom of God being within him from which he could enlarge his territory around him.

ii. possessed the authority of a customs agent

a. the power to pass people and things through, detain, destroy, stop, and/or seize for the use of the government.

J. The Kingdom of God is "BTSTG".

1. BTSTG is the acrostic for Believe to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living based on promises you are expecting to be manifested in the earth.

i. Completely inheriting the kingdom of God depends on

a. what God can do through you with your faith, orchestrate

b. how sensitive and responsive you are to God with your faith, obedience

c. if you fully incorporate God into your affairs with your faith, occupy

K. Establish your self-portrait using God's promises

1. Jesus Christ ransomed you from satan, led captivity captive, so you can be debt free (Hebrews 2:14, 15)
2. Jesus Christ redeemed you from the curse of the law, which includes any lack, debt and poverty so you can be entitled to the blessing of Abraham (Galatians 3:13, Genesis 12:1-3)
3. Jesus is the Jubilee, i.e., supernatural debt cancellation (Leviticus 27:24)
4. God desired to establish his covenant with all mankind so they will have his power supply to get wealth (Deuteronomy 8:18)
5. Faith in God is how you make your living. (Romans 1:17)
6. Faith in God justifies payments for all ordained expenses. (Romans 5:1)
7. Grace is the supplier for the kingdom of God's economy, not just trusting in the FDIC (II Corinthians 9:8)
8. Favor is better than money. Favor gives you something of value that someone always wanted you to have.
 - i. Favor can't be sold, bought, or won. However, it can be sown and reaped.
 - ii. "A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold." (Proverbs 22:1)
9. Sowing and reaping represents God's economy throughout every age in the earth. (Galatians 6:7-8)
10. Mercy canceled all debt, so you can live forgiven and be free from guilt and shame. There is absolutely no judgment in mercy. (Isaiah 55:7)
11. Repentance reconciles your relationship to God and others so you can receive what you don't deserve. (Matthew 6:14, 15)
12. Obedience keeps the harvest flowing consistently because you are always at the right place at the right time during the right thing. (Job 36:11)
13. Owe no one but to love others unconditionally (Romans 13:8)
14. Restoration doesn't give us just what was lost, but is faithful to bestow God's original intentions (Joel 2nd chapter)
15. Heaven's inheritance positions us to receive the double portion as a joint heir with Jesus, instead of a servant under the old covenant or slave under the world system (Romans 8:16, 17)

i. He oversees the whole territory to fulfill his assignment so nothing is missing, lacking, or broken.

ii. God highly exalted Jesus and honored him by bestowing on him his own authority. (Philippians 2:9-11)

iii. The government of the kingdom of God is upon his shoulder to administer salvation in the earth. (Isaiah 9:6)

iv. Of the increase of his government and of his kingdom shall be no end, so it is everlasting and will be enlarged. (Isaiah 9:7)

v. No man on earth and no devil ever took anything away from Jesus Christ. He laid it all down as an incorruptible seed to reap you as part of his harvested inheritance. (John 10:15-18)

vi. Jesus Christ did not think it was robbery to be equal with God. He did not take anything away from God, but made the way for God to have his family restored to him. (Philippians 2:6)

2. Jesus Christ, the world overcomer

i. "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I overcome the world." (John 16:33)

a. The peace of God is a benefit of Jesus Christ's conquest. While on assignment as heaven's ambassador, it guarantees that you have nothing missing, lacking, or broken.

b. If you are in Christ during a trial, you have the capacity to remain whole, without even flinching.

ii. He will see the travail of his soul and be satisfied. (Isaiah 53:11)

a. He is not going to be disappointed with what he receives as his inheritance.

b. You will not be disappointed with the inheritance you receive from him.

3. The believer's faith in God overcomes the world; making you a world overcomer also.

i. "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth is the Son of God?" (I John 5:4-5)

4. The kingdom of God is incomparable to the kingdom of this world.
 - i. "...greater is he that is in me, than he that in the world." (I John 4:4)
5. The believer's application of the Blood and the Word for victory.
 - i. "And we overcame him [satan] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony and we loved not our lives unto the death." (Revelation 12:11)
6. The believer's application of the love of God, so you can't be overthrown.
 - i. "...to be as Jesus is in the world." (I John 4:7)
7. The believer's assignment in the world to reposition the kingdom of God.
 - i. "...These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;" (Acts 17:6)
8. Believers are destined to be repositioned as the head instead of the tail in the earth.
 - i. What was last will be first and vice versa. (Matthew 19:30)
 - ii. It is going to be a swift work, like turning a salt shaker over.
9. Believers have been bequeathed peace as an eternal inheritance.
 - i. "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." (John 14:27)
 - ii. The world system attempts to measure up to the peace of God, But in reality, it only assimilates a temporary, fleeting peace that is pleasurable for a season, ultimately painful. But in the end, it will always leave you with something missing, lacking, and broken. The peace of God always ensures wholeness at all times.

1. Which culture do you support? the kingdom of God? or the kingdom of this world?
2. Can you envision yourself successfully triumphing over the world system? If you can't, then meditate in the Word all the time until you receive revelation, interpretation, and fruition.
3. Focus on the kingdom of God principles as your influence, as well as, cut off the voice of the world that distorts God's view.
4. What one thing can you do to show your commitment to prosper in the principles of the kingdom of God, as well as, oppose the kingdom of this world?
5. Make sure every word you live by is the Word of God and not twisted truth.

V. Recommended Reading to Improve your Bottom Line

Confessions that endorse more than one stream

Begin to think outside the box. God can do just one thing and everything in your life changes for the better. This entails possibility thinking. Beyond need fulfillment. Beyond the desires of your heart. Beyond your thoughts and requests, which means it is in a realm of embracing the impossible with a sense of not just possibility, but probability. Don't just include income, but think in terms of increase. Then you won't be just limited to just currency. Proverbs 22:1 states that favor is better than currency. Why? The party who favors makes all their resources available to you. If you have a choice between money and favor, always choose favor. Express gratitude to God for:

1 – Receive Expected increase from Expected sources. This is a return on investment like a paycheck, retirement, social security, benefit package. You know it exists and you are positioned as a recipient because you meet the requirements for it to flow to you.

2 – Receive Expected increase from Unexpected sources. This is a return on investment where you anticipate streams from your seed, but don't know all the direct or indirect channels that may funnel it back to you.

3 – Receive Unexpected increase from Expected sources. This is a return on investment from parties who owe you don't have intentions on making it right, but they will be made to repay you in any area that they tried to defraud you, including restitution for pain and suffering.

4 - Unexpected increase from Unexpected sources. This is a return on investment where the source and the substance are both unknown, but it yields an increase. When you receive unexpected increase from unexpected sources as a stream of increase, it becomes a sure way for God to get to you the exceeding, abundant above all that you can ask for or think of. This breeds receiving an inheritance where you may or may not have sown, but favor is extended to you. This area represents the mystery of the seed because it is growing underground. This area also represents the mystery of the harvest, because both you and satan are unaware that's its destination is your address. Therefore, you can receive an on-time and intact delivery because the harvest did not experience any interference, interruption, or interception. All seed and harvest are present to God: some are just seen or unseen. Give God the right of way by allowing him to share the mystery of his will so you can possess your inheritance. Just because it is unseen doesn't mean that it is not there, only invisible to the naked eye. When you yield all probable sources of increase, as well as, your increase to God, you are commanding the invisible to manifest for you but God is the one who directs it to you. God runs an undercover operation for the purpose of overthrowing the enemy's intelligence. This is a harvest that the enemy cannot stop, because he doesn't have any clue where it is coming from or where it is going. Therefore, delivery of the unexpected is inevitable because it never has an enemy. The removal of opposition ensures smooth transitions.

Some only wish for increase while having doubt about making ends meet. Some wander around robbing Peter to pay Paul. Still others wonder about possession, but never make their requests known to God with thanksgiving, so in return they are left empty-handed. Discard wishing, wandering, and wondering, and will to be an eyewitness and a minister of the kingdom of God in the earth.

The Confession of a Wealthy Heir

As a highly favored adopted son/daughter of God, I have full rights to my inheritance. Being a joint heir with Jesus Christ automatically gives me a double portion, the right of the first born. I call God, Daddy, Daddy, which is the foundation of my inheritance. God's covenant with me is established, so I'm empowered to get wealth. He makes good on all his promises because of his oath and word are unchangeable. I've made the exchange: I'm not the poor trying to be rich. I'm the rich, so I won't allow satan to take my inheritance. Send prosperity now and I will receive it the way you send it. I have the sevenfold return for what has been lost, stolen, and destroyed. I will keep going back until I not only possess the land. I have durable riches with righteousness. Angels hearken to the voice of the Lord to bring the manifestation of God's promises to me. I'm not a slave nor servant, but a master to money. My soul prospers. Therefore, I am satisfied not to steal, beg, borrow, cheat, covet, bow to other gods, misappropriate the Lord's name, defraud or manipulate the way that is before me. I walk at liberty and won't be entangled in the yoke of bondage of poverty, debt, and lack. The Lord has set me on high because I have known his name: Redeemer, Lord of Sabaoth, Promoter, Jehovah Gmolah, Lord of Hosts, and Teacher of Profit. I have been delivered from the world's system of economics. I owe no man, but to love. I am a tither which positions God to defend all my economic transactions. Sowing and reaping are the cause of my increase. Fear, terror, and oppression will not keep me from receiving from others and others from receiving from me. Fear, apprehension, and dread will not keep me from giving to others and others from giving to me. I have made room for God to regulate everything that is irregular, so now the uncommon flow of harvest is common. God has crowned every year of my life with his goodness. What God calls a good thing, I call excellent. I have received goods, services, time, and income to support the kingdom of God's gain. I am not dependent upon the current economic system of supply and demand because it is interdependent. The grace of God independently supplies the kingdom of God. I possess enough of God to be a delightful land. God commanded his blessing upon my storehouse, so that I never run out of anything. Wealth and riches are in my house, so I have accumulated more than what's needed and desired for my own household. Now I am a ready distribution center for the kingdom of God. God can negotiate with me to do his good work and charity. God recompenses me for all my work. I firmly abide in a circle of blessing. I am in the loop. Every valley has been exalted. Every mountain and hill made low. Every crooked place, straight. Every rough place smooth. God has prepared a table for me in the presence of my enemies and it's an international media event.

Mirror the Word, the Image of Heaven

Judges 6th - 8th chapters recount the story of Gideon. His poor self-image mirrored that he was poor, afraid, rejected, and defeated because the Midianites always succeeded at destroying their crops and stealing their livestock every harvest for seven years straight. Although he confessed he was poor, the story reveals otherwise. Gideon's family was financially sound, but he had a poor self-image. Poor folks don't have more than 10 servants. Poor folks' fathers don't have a best ox. Poor folks don't wear apparel like a king, especially during battle. Once Gideon was healed from oppression, the Holy Spirit empowered him to rise as a mighty man of valor. He allowed the anointing to reposition him from hiding from the enemy to chasing and overtaking the ones who defrauded him, although he had only 300 shouting men who had trumpets and lanterns as their main arsenal. Even after they became tired and hungry, they pursued the enemy because Gideon was confident God would respond to him during the battle. He pursued the promised victory in front of him by honoring God through obedience. He made room to receive widespread influence of God's and his own sword which gave him favor among his people and dread among his enemies. Until Gideon recognized his clout with God and man, he operated in the red and remained bankrupt. Just like Gideon, once you mirror your image by heaven's standards, the Word of God, you will never come home empty again. Here's your promise if you are subject to unjust gain and unfair labor practices found in Isaiah 9:4. "For thou hast broken the yoke of his burden, and the staff of his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, as in the day of Midian."

The Expiration Date Extended

Premature death is under the curse of the law, but we have been redeemed from it. Instead many still believe premature death is God's way of life. Abiding in the circle of blessing preserves your life from destruction. Many excuses are made when people die. It's said. It must have been their time. Others accuse God of taking their loved ones. They say God needed them in heaven. In reality, the devil snatched their life. Genesis 6:3 records 120 years as God's promise for mankind's life span in the earth. When what comes out of God's mouth is allowed to fill yours, it will bring satisfaction, i.e., long life and length of days as found in Psalm 21:4. That's God's promise to you, no matter if all your loved ones have died at an early age. Psalm 103:5 says that the Lord satisfies your mouth with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagles -strong, soaring, and overcoming. Don't let anyone or anything cheat you out of long life and your ministry to mankind. Moses still had his eyesight and strength at 120 years when he died as recorded in Deuteronomy 34:7. Moses, the author of Psalm 90, was interceding to God to remove the curse of 60-70 years from the disobedient in verse 10. Here's your way of escape from premature death. O death, where is your sting? O grave, where is your victory? "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is the devil; and deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." Hebrews 2:14-15.

Total Life Prosperity

Any area you choose not to invite God to participate in and believe to receive his best will be the same area the enemy will steal, kill, and/or destroy from you. For example, if you believe in financial prosperity, but don't believe in physical prosperity, the devil will steal your health and then use your money to buy medicine. He then will try to hold you in bondage until you get worse and have spent all your money. The remedy. Read healing and financial prosperity Scriptures aloud daily whether or not you need them. From the flow of your mouth, you will build a stronghold against the enemy. "No weapon formed against you shall prosper and every tongue that ariseth up against you shall be condemned [fail]..." Isaiah 54:17

Succession

Premature death causes a breakdown in proper succession. It reduces the time, money, energy, skill, wisdom, and other resources required to jump start the next generation. With the three deaths recorded in Ruth, the lifeline was cut off. However, God restored the seed of eternal life, resurrection life, and abundant life through the Boaz-Ruth link. They were great-grandparents to King David. With this reconnection, Jesus Christ came into the earth to deliver us from spiritual and premature death. It also restored the lives of Naomi and Ruth and gave them a new beginning with Boaz. It was twofold: something great accomplished for the kingdom of God and something great accomplished in their personal lives.

Prayer Mapping

The greater the territory you own, the greater options you will have. Enlarge your territory by faith. For example. Use the map of the USA below. Call each state by name and say aloud in prayer, "Ohio is God's." After you have completed calling out all the names say, "Your will be done in earth as it is in heaven so that we can experience the days of heaven upon the earth. For the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdom of our God and his Christ and you shall reign [uninterruptedly] forever. We receive your preservation, protection, provision, and prosperity in the reclaimed territory in Jesus' name. Amen." As the Lord leads you, be committed to give your utmost attention to prayer mapping, no matter how large the territory is currently.

Originally, home ownership was beyond my reach. I could only see myself in an apartment, but never in a house I could call my own home. I had shallow relationships with other banks who just wanted me to have a savings account, checking account, and credit card debt, but they had no real interest in me going any further. My friend prompted me to listen to a radio talk show where I heard Clifford King discuss Dollar Bank's first-time homeowner's program. His discussion removed all doubt, although I had no savings to commit to purchasing a home. I contacted the bank corporate headquarters and met with Dorothy Curtis who took my goal for home ownership and helped me to realize my dream. Having been somewhat overextended in debt, Dollar Bank approved a debt consolidation loan, which created moneys to save for my home. She created a budget and gently adjusted my living expenses to which I submitted to. I had to be delivered from a high maintenance mentality, so I disciplined myself to a new lifestyle. She never said a word about my tithing allowance. I got off the broad way and abided within the narrow path to home ownership because I knew it would enlarge my territory. I also created leverage with Dorothy whereby after a saving deposit was made; I would call her to report every addition monthly. I never wanted to report less than the previous month's sum. Within six months I had my down payment required so returned to get pre-qualified for a mortgage. Before I looked for a home, I itemized a very specific list of what I desired, so that I would know it when I saw it. That list was very precise because my employer required me to live in Cleveland and I only wanted to live in a certain quadrant in that boundary within my price range. When I prayed about the home, I felt very unworthy about asking God for it although I was a faithful tither. My lack of confidence was based on my lack of intimacy with the Lord. Plus I did not know my

covenant rights that Jesus paid for. One thing I knew for sure is that if I was going to get anything that it would come through heaven's open windows. Wanting to ignite my request so the house would surface, at the prompting of the Lord I shared expenses in purchasing two rooms of carpet for a party. Within a short period, I saw an ad and I knew in my heart that it was "my house". November, 2008 marks thirteen years in my home. The original loan repayment was for 30 years. The beginning of 2004, I refinanced my loan through Dollar Bank. As of this publication date, I have only 10 years left on the mortgage until the home will be paid for in full, instead of 16 years. Plus the market value of the home has substantially increased.

Tips to Help you Succeed on the Road named Progress

- Establish your ultimate goal to master your money, time, relationships, and energy.
- Expect Jesus Christ to add value to your life so that it will be abundantly supplied.
- Bring your tithes (10% of all your gross increase) cheerfully.
- Give committed offerings of your time, money, prayer, energy. Sow to the level that you want to live on.
- Expect a smooth transition from seed time to harvest time.
- Ask God to fill your mouth with good words, so you won't be the cause of a crop failure.
- Make the Word of God your most valuable treasure.
- Know your covenant blessing and be familiar with the curse of the law in Deuteronomy 28 chapter.
- Study the subject of economics and finances, so you will be able to rightly divide the truth.
- Ask God for and receive forgiveness immediately anytime there is waste, misuse, or abuse intentionally or unintentionally.
- Don't break the law. Stay far away from paying bills that involve crime.
- Keep your pulse on your results so you won't settle for receiving the curse of the law.
- Make an appeal to the Heavenly Father when results don't look like God's promise.
- Make sure there are no holes in your bags. Be watchful of seepage.
- Get God's direction on every decision and be determined to follow every detail. Wait to receive the wisdom of God, the ability to choose the best.
- Allow God to negotiate with you to supply others, family, friends and foes and watch the harvest overtake you.
- Be faithful to partake of the promises of God daily.
- Confess that you have the supply to be in demand; and your supply is in demand.
- Expect increase for all those who supply you.
- Pray for others in the areas of finances: your employer, business, ministry, church, city, and nation.

- Believe for prolonged life for your assets so that they won't run out, breakdown, or become obsolete.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to the best products/services at the most affordable price.
- Strive for optimum pre-maintenance rather than repair or replacement. It costs less.
- Don't defraud anyone. Digest I Corinthians 13:4-8 daily in the Amplified Bible because faith is employed by love.
- When you keep your promises, they become seeds that are sown for God to keep his promises to you.

Choose the Highest Degree

There are four degrees of progressive increase in the kingdom of God: the gleaner; reaper; partaker; and the inheritor. When Adam and Eve were evicted from the Garden of Eden, they got demoted down two grades, from working their God-given inheritance to just a reaper, a class reserved for angels, our designated servants. Originally, God created mankind to have dominion over everything that flies, swims, and creeps, even "the creep" satan. Trying to be something that they already were removed the glory of God from them and replaced it with shame. The only revelation they received from their encounter with satan was that they were naked. Shame consciousness is embedded in the earth so many tend to believe they are trapped in that state. When you don't receive the mercy of God, you operate as if Adam had eaten from the tree of life after he partook from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If Adam had eaten of the tree of life afterward, he would have preserved him in sin forever with no potential way of escape. However, Jesus restored to mankind the right to the tree of life. Proverbs 3 declares that wisdom is the tree of life when you lay hold upon her. She helps you to choose the best. Therefore, every decision can be marked by precision, so your results will always lead to eternal life, not premature death. The best decision in life is choosing what God would choose for you every time. Psalm 47:4 promises, "He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah." The wisdom from above will help you experience the inheritance Adam was privileged to prior to The Fall. You will be replanted in the Garden of Eden as Psalm 1:3, The Message, declares. [Read James 3:13-18 daily] Decisions determine destiny; destiny is not a place, it is a position.

Which Name should I Call?

Some time ago, I was one of the prime candidates for a job promotion. When I didn't get it I became distraught. I became angry toward God. During those moments, I questioned the Lord. I asked him why I didn't get that promotion. He replied you don't know him. Although I faithfully paid my tithes, I didn't know him by any of his financial names. In Psalm 91:14 God promises this. "Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high because he hath known my name." For financial gain some of the Lord's names are: The Lord of Hosts, The Redeemer, The Teacher of Profit, The Promoter, The Lord of Sabaoth, and Jehovah Gmolah or use *The*

Promise of God's Name which lists all the names of God. But the name God really refers is "Abba Father" or Daddy, Daddy which repositions us a child of God, an heir of God, and a joint-heir with Jesus Christ. With heavenly family status, you recognize and accept your right to God's inheritance, which is far greater than a job promotion. It is the ministry of the Holy Spirit that helps you get acquainted with God as your Everlasting Father. When new members come into a family by marriage or adoption, oftentimes the parents tell them to call them, Mom or Dad. At first, they normally feel very uncomfortable so they revert to calling them Mr. or Mrs. But once that relationship builds the freedom to practice Mom or Dad becomes a reality. Reference Romans 8:14-17.

Who's NUW in your life?

Never Underestimate Who God will send to take you to the next level up. Although Naomi combated Ruth from the onset, God assigned her to be Naomi's temporary breadwinner which eventually afforded her the right to receive redemption. In the end, Ruth was acknowledged as being better than seven sons to Naomi. Finally yielding to Ruth's companionship, Naomi opened up to receive the sevenfold restoration from the enemy who had stolen the lives of her husband and two sons. I have learned that one day of favor is worth more than a lifetime of labor.

Always Believe in Miracles

Ask for and expect miracles when things go wrong. Miracles redeem the time because they reduce the necessary growing time to bring about maturation with greater acceleration. Therefore when miracles take place, the seed time and harvest time is not representative of the Law of Harvest, i.e., seed time - growing time - harvest time. Miracles operate beyond natural boundaries to yield a quicker harvest. The Word of God is only bound to time or space when you keep it within the four corners of a natural world system. When you release your faith to receive your miracles, you won't be behind anymore. It's a valid supernatural system God uses to play catch-up.

The Bankrupt Triangle

The spirit of poverty produces a failure to thrive. I have learned that it reigns over new projects to keep them from succeeding. When it is present, there is a flickering pulse or no signs of life at all which makes lack abound. Debt then surfaces in order to take care of the lack, which creates more lack and increased debt. Collectively, a yoke of bondage is created that cycle, having no plans to ever let you go free. But Deuteronomy 8:9 promises, "A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any thing in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass."

Basket and Storehouse

"If your profits are in heaven your heart will be there too." Matthew 6:21 (The Living Bible). Your heart holds the quantity and quality of the treasures you deposit. Don't just live on bread alone, but every Word that proceeds out of the mouth of God. Then your life will transform by what you continually digest. The basketful portion is the amount of the Word of God you deposit daily that you need for survival. The storehouse portion is

the Word of God you deposit daily that you don't need daily but you deposit daily to keep your faith always overflowing and operating at a level of success all the time.

The Great Exchange

God gave us the best that heaven could afford. Why would God then withhold anything from you in the earth? "He who did not withhold or spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely and graciously give us all [other] things?" Romans 8:32, The Amplified. Jesus willingly reduced himself so low to take you to the highest position heaven could afford, from slavery to sonship. And it was his gentleness that made you so honorable. The Great Exchange is this: Jesus satisfied all our debt by becoming beggarly so that you may live in abundance. "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sakes became poor, that you through his poverty, might be rich." II Corinthians 8:9. According to heaven's standards, the substance, riches, and wealth in the earth would be considered poverty-stricken. For example, the streets of heaven are paved with gold, while asphalt surfaces our earthy roads. Please know that the grace of God supplies all demands. Make your demand on your covenant rights.

A City Fit for the Hill

The Spirit of God impressed upon me that one of the reasons that Cleveland, Ohio is in a failure to thrive because of God's people, ministries, churches, businesses are not tithing. I then asked him how I could handle that. He said that faith justifies that expense. Corporately let's believe and confess that Cleveland, Ohio is 100% tithers. 3 Approaches to the Promise Land

- (1) **Explorer** - just visiting with no plans to relocate
- (2) **Settler** - just renting or leasing space with no plans to purchase
- (3) **Possessor** - abiding in the circle of blessing in the Promised Land. Once you acquire land, you can build or buy what you desire on it. If you don't own anything, you won't have any "say-so."
